Density meter - - - Colorado state troopers - - - illegal search (actually all state troopers)

In 1996, a friend of mine had a small used-tool shop that was frequented by a state trooper. (The trooper would buy tools for his wood lathe.) One day that summer, I entered the shop just as the trooper was leaving. My friend's eyes were as big as silver dollars.
